



Packing Checklist

for Campers

Use this checklist as a reminder of what to pack for camp. Please put camper's name on all personal items and clothing. Do not bring items of significant value (expensive jewelry, etc). Clothing should not contain foul language or pictures of alcohol or tobacco advertising. Please refer to the dress code before packing your camper's clothing.

Bible and pen or pencil. <i>No digital Bibles allowed. Paper Bibles only.</i>			
Change of clothes for 6 days. <i>Bring extras. Days are hot and clothes get sweaty. Clothes must be modest. Please refer to the dress code stated on the numerous communications you have already received or on the website.</i>			
Pool attire. <i>Knee-length swim shorts (board shorts) and DARK T-shirts or DARK sleeveless t-shirts.</i>			
Bug Spray			
Sunglasses/Hat/Sunscreen			
Soap/Shampoo/Toothbrush/Toothpaste/Brush/Comb/Deodorant/Chaffing Stick			
Towels & washcloths (<i>junior camper only</i>)/Beach Towel (<i>all campers</i>)			
Water Sandals/Shoes (for shower & pool)			
Clothes/Costume for "Country Music Festival" event			
Flashlight			
Snacks. <i>No items requiring refrigeration and must be in air-sealed containers.</i>			
Camp Store Money. <i>We prefer you to directly deposit store money into the camp store account. You can do this on our website. .</i>			
Medicine. <i>Please bring prescription medicines only. Our nursing staff supplies OTC meds. Put all medicines in one Ziploc bag labeled with the camper's name. Prescription medicines must be in original container prescribed to camper.</i>			
Tennis shoes for sports			
Sports equipment for afternoon competitive games			
Laundry Bag			
Clothes drying rack (for wet swim clothes and towels)			
Over the door hook (for use on bunk beds for bath towel in cabins)			
Umbrella or poncho			
Water Bottle			
Sensory ear protection for loud environments if needed			
Alarm clock for senior campers (<i>since no phones are allowed</i>) - <i>no radio</i>			

**Campers assigned to cabins should bring bedding for twin size beds. Campers assigned to lodges will share Queen beds and will have linens provided. As space permits, extra twin air mattresses will be provided for those who bring twin sheets and do not want to share a bed.
